August Bar Star: Kelli at the Century Bar

We are presenting a new feature in Dayton937: our monthly "Bar Star"! In this issue we get to know Kelli Nikanowicz, manager of The Century, the world-famous bourbon bar at 18 S. Jefferson Ave in downtown Dayton



It started as a side hustle to make money for college. I started working as a cart girl at a golf course by my house and we would occasionally get asked to work events. Once I realized how much fun I had doing those and how many people you could meet...it was an easy choice.

2. What is your favorite drink to make?

Whiskey neat. Haha just kidding, thats the easiest. I actually really like making a Sazerac. It's a great classic cocktail but you'd be surprised how many terrible ones I've had. I'm forever on the search for people that are do them right and this makes me want to make mine for everyone.

3. Do you have a favorite spirit you like to work with?

Bourbon would be the one everyone expects me to say, but I've been into Rums lately. I like to take a classic rum drink and rework it to make more sense with the ingredients available to us today. There are really delicious tiki drinks that shine once you tweak the ingredients and rums.

4. What do you do when you are not bartending?

I try and spend time relaxing with friends and family. I am extremely lucky to have made some amazing friends here over the years, they really are more like my Dayton family. I love going to concerts and seeing live music. I also really enjoy being outdoors or on the water, even though that has proven more difficult here than where I grew up.

5. What advice do you give bartenders getting into the business?

It's not for everyone. It's hard. There are long shifts and late nights. You will forever be on a schedule opposite from the events your friends go to. But it's also the best thing I've ever done. You'll meet the most amazing people and you'll learn skills you can take anywhere. Get your foot in the door, take any job that you can and work your way up. It's how you learn how to do everything and you'll be more successful for it.

6. What do you love most about Dayton?

Everything?!? I love the location, it's just as easy to visit friends in Cincinnati and Kentucky as it is to go home to Michigan. In other cities I've lived in, 45-60 min was my commute home from work. The community, as I mentioned. There are so many people doing great things here. We have amazing coffee spots, breweries, live shows, bike trails, parks, etc. (a nationally ranked bourbon bar, cough, cough) I could go on and on!

7. If you were not a bartender, what career would you be pursuing?

Most do not know this, but I actually worked at an architecture firm in Ann Arbor before I moved to Dayton. Part of my decision to not go back into that field was the insecurity of it all. One minute there are so many projects that you are working overtime every night and the next the firm is laying off staff because all the projects got canceled. I know that is true of many fields, as we saw over the last year. But something about this industry makes me happy. And I'm also willing to bet that someone, somewhere will always need a drink.
