



Event Feature: Dayton Battle of the Bands

Dayton Battle of the Bands was an initiative that originally ran from Jan through February 2020 before the COVID epidemic occurred. It was launched as a collaboration between music promoters at Sound Valley Dayton and Venus Child Productions, and a new downtown Dayton local music venue, The Brightside (905 E 3rd St).

The goal of Dayton Battle of the Bands is to shine a light on new and upcoming bands in the community while providing a prize package that helps launch them to their next level. The series runs for 6 weeks on Thursdays 7-10pm, with 4 bands per night, competing to win their week, & move onto the Finals on Sat, Feb 26, 2022.

While the winners will receive an EP studio session at Dayton Sound Studios (sponsors of the event) and a cash prize, all the finalists win some very exciting prizes too: a live music video from Sound Valley and an opening spot on Levitt Dayton's summer 2022 lineup!

Winners of each week are decided by a combo of audience & judges' votes. Judges are a mix of local music industry pros. The final winner is selected by audience votes only. Shows at The Brightside.

"In reality, it's less of a battle and more of an amazing networking opportunity for local bands and musicians," Carli Dixon, owner of The Brightside shared with us. "And this year is extra special because of this collaboration between all of us and Levitt Dayton."

Business Feature: The Bottle Shop

Ghostlight Coffee started selling zero-proof spirits in 2020, during the COVID-19 pandemic. Shane Anderson, owner of Ghostlight Coffee, and his wife Lezley Pisone, had been diving into the world of nonalcoholic spirits at home and wanted to share the opportunity with the Dayton community. What started as a single shelf of products has transformed into a full-fledged bottle shop located inside the historic coffeehouse located at 1201 Wayne Avenue.

The Bottle Shop by Ghostlight boasts a varied selection of zero-proof spirits and "social beverages," as the shop calls them. Customers can choose from familiar spirits such as gin, whiskey, tequila and rum (all with no alcohol) as well as pre-mixed "cocktails" and unique herbal elixirs. A variety of sparkling beverages,

"clean" wines, non-alcoholic craft beer, cocktail syrups, aperitifs, aromatic bitters, all crafted without alcohol.

"I'm pleasantly surprised to experience some bar cart staples and unique herbal elixirs that are now a part of

elixirs that are now a part of my evening 'unwind' ritual," said Pisone, who chooses an alcohol-free lifestyle but has enjoyed the taste of cocktails in the past.

The demand for better non-alcoholic beverages has been growing rapidly since the start of the pandemic. Prior to recent years, those abstaining from alcohol for any reason often had few choices. Water, soda, or if you were lucky, a tonic with lime was probably the best you'd find. "Sober bars" and non-alcoholic cocktails have been popping up with greater frequency nation-wide, but Ghostlight Coffee's Bottle Shop will be the first of its kind in Ohio.

The Bottle Shop was completed in time for "Dry January" to support those who may be adjusting their habits in the new year. Ghostlight plans to offer a limited menu of zero-proof cocktails and host special events. Open 1pm-6pm Mon - Saturday. Shopping & case requests can be made to ghostlightsouthpark@gmail.
